



MORRINSVILLE SHOW ADMINISTRATION

Entries & Payments

- \Rightarrow Entries are to be received on or before 19 February 2024. Late entries will be accepted if accompanied by a late fee of \$20.00 per animal.
- ⇒ Entries will be taken in all sections on the day, and a penalty will be added for entries that are late, <u>UNLESS</u> the sections <u>only take the entries on the day</u> and only these sections, will have no penalty added.
- \Rightarrow Tickets are to be produced to the Gate Person, otherwise you will be required to pay to enter. Please do not forget your tickets.
 - \Rightarrow Except for Calf Club and Young Handler classes, prize money will be paid directly into your bank account after the show.
- \Rightarrow All entries must be printed clearly.
- \Rightarrow All entry forms must be signed.
- \Rightarrow <u>ONLINE ENTRIES</u> will be available through <u>Home | Main-Events</u> Alternatively entries will be accepted through post or email using the entry form supplied.

RULES & REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE SHOW

- 1. Forbidden Substances This applies to ALL sections of the Morrinsville A & P Show.
- 2. Any animal may be tested for drugs or forbidden substances at any show under the By-Laws & Regulations adopted by the RAS & the procedures adopted by the FSJC.
- 3. Exhibitors or Persons entering or competing in Shows or Events affiliated to the RAS shall be deemed to accept & be bound by these By-Laws Regulations & Procedures.
- 4. Drugs & Forbidden Substances means any substance capable of effecting speed, stamina, courage, conformation or conduct of an animal by its action upon the central or peripheral nervous system or cardio-vascular, respiratory, alimentary, digestive, musco skeletal or urogenital systems.
- 5. The following practices are banned from the Dairy Cattle section of all A&P Shows, refer to the Dairy Cattle Section.
- 6. From the time any animal enters the grounds of any show or event or competes in any class or event the Society or its duly appointed officer shall have the powers to order a drug test & if a test is ordered, the existing FSJC rules suitably adapted in accordance with the type of animal being tested & procedures & fines shall apply.
- 7. Please note that the Morrinsville A & P Society is no longer registered for GST.
- 8. Refunding Entry Fees: A refund of fees will be made on presentation of a doctor's or veterinary certificate, at the discretion of the committee. There will be no refunds under \$10. Please note that online entry fees are non-refundable.
- 9. Attendant's tickets for exhibitors with a large number of exhibits will be issued at the rate of 1 per 3 exhibits on application to the Secretary.
- 10. Entries close 19 February 2024, LATE entries will be accepted but are liable for an addition fee of \$20 per animal.
- 11. All entries received must be paid for when the entry is submitted.
- 12. Prize money will be paid into your nominated bank account after the show.
- 13. If suitable, Classes with less than three entries may be combined.
- 14. For classes with a small number of entries Prize Money will be paid as follows:

Three competitors or less – 1st Prize only will be paid out

- Four competitors 1st and 2nd prizes will be paid out
- Five competitors or more -1^{st} , 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} prizes will be paid.
- 15. Each exhibitor must supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazards created or accident, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves or their animals at the show grounds.
- 16. Exhibitors must comply with appropriate Animal Legislation and the Health & Safety in Employment Act 2015 & amendments thereafter. By entering the Show you agree to abide by the terms and conditions of the Morrinsville A & P Society.
- 17. No person is permitted in any Judging Ring without express permission from the Head Steward of that ring.
- 18. Only persons directly responsible for an Exhibit are permitted in the marshalling area.
- 19. The Morrinsville A & P Society or any other organisations in conjunction with the show will not be held accountable for any cancellation of all or part of the show. Refunds will be looked at due to unforeseen circumstances and you will be contacted accordingly.

For Cattle being moved from 1 July 2012 a NAIT approved RFID Tag is mandatory for all movements of Cattle, including Calves. NAIT approved RFID cattle tags are white only. Please do not remove tags if cattle are identified with Animal Health Board or MINDA Tags.

As of 1 July 2012, a secondary tag is no longer required under the new NAIT scheme.

Where live cattle form part of a trade display the exhibitor is responsible for:

Ensuring all stock have completed all TB Testing requirements as per Animal Health Board testing regulations.

Ensuring all stock are identified in accordance with current legal requirements.

IMPORTANT: It is the Exhibitors' responsibility to record all animal movements with NAIT 48 hours prior to leaving the Farm/property for the Show and then within 48 hours of returning to the Farm/property from the Show.

TUBERCULOSIS TESTING: (2 DOCUMENTS REQUIRED)

NO CATTLE FROM A MOVEMENT CONTROL HERD MAY BE EXHIBITED

T.B. STATUS (CATTLE, DEER & OTHER TB PRONE ANIMALS)

As per the current Bio-security requirements:

All animals entered for showing or exhibiting must be from a current TB Clear Status Herd.

A Copy of the current TB Test Certificate must be attached to entry forms. The Association must be notified at the time of entry of any testing to be carried out after the closing date of entries or of any potential TB issues that may arise after entries have been submitted. Owners entering Cattle must sign any declaration printed on the entry form.

There are two documents required:

• First document is a TB Test Certificate. For animals from a Declared Movement Control Area- all animals aged three months or older are to be TB Tested and have a clear test within 60 days prior to being moved to the Show. All other animals must be from a herd that is up to date with its current routine TB testing requirements.

• Second document is a TB Animal Status Declaration Card. This is a legal requirement for all animals being moved. All animals entered must be accompanied in transit by a signed and dated TB Animal Status Declaration Card showing a TB Clear status in accordance with present legislation. Animal individual numbers must be included on the TB test sheet. These cards may be inspected at the unloading area.

PROTEST: Covering all Sections:

All protests must be in writing & must be entered with the secretary no later than 15 minutes after the event. The party entering a protest must deposit \$100.00.

The deposit will be returned if the protest is sustained.

The Committee will decide all protests as soon as practicable and there shall be no appeal from their decision.

Protest committee are: President & Secretary or Vice President & Chief Steward of the ring concerned.

- i. Yellow Card. This Show/Event supports the RAS "Yellow Card" system. A Yellow Card will be issued, in cases of offences in respect of abuse of animals or inappropriate behaviour as per the RAS Constitution and the RAS Rules & Regulation/Bylaws including the Equestrian Rulebook, the RAS affiliated Show/Event/registered Measuring Stand and their grounds and their duly appointed delegates may deliver to the Person Responsible a Yellow Warning Card (either immediately or within 10 days of the show) which suspends any penalty until possible new offences. Full wording of the "Yellow Card" system is available to view on the RAS website <u>www.ras.org.nz</u>
- ii. Forbidden Substances The Rules of the Royal A&P Society New Zealand in regard to Forbidden Substances apply. Competitors are advised that tests for forbidden substances may be carried out during the Show/Event and that testing of all animals is at the person responsible risk. Forbidden Substance Any substance capable of affecting the speed, stamina, courage or conduct of a horse, pony, donkey or mule by its action upon the central or peripheral nervous system or the cardio-vascular, respiratory, alimentary, digestive, muscoskeletal or urogenital systems.
- iii. Arrears No person who is in arrears with regard to entry fees, subscriptions, or any other show/event charge is eligible to compete at any affiliated Show/Event. Proof of payment will be required before any restriction is lifted.
- iv. Summary of RAS Resolution Process the full process can be found on the RAS website www.ras.org.nz. The principle behind the process is to deal with the matter as it comes to hand and in most cases it should be dealt with directly by the Show. If the matter is in regards to an RAS official, the Show may request the assistance of RAS Head Office as to how to deal with this in an appropriate manner.

ENTRIES CLOSE 19 FEBRUARY - LATE ENTRIES AND ENTRIES ON THE DAY WILL BE ACCEPTED WITH A LATE ENTRY FEE OF \$20 PER ANIMAL. YOU WILL HAVE TO PAY A GATE ENTRY IF THERE IS NOT ENOUGH TIME TO GUARANTEE THAT TICKETS WILL ARRIVE TO YOU IN TIME. THESE ARE NON-REFUNDABLE.

BEEF SECTION RULES:

TB details as detailed. Protest refers to section. NOTE

Bulls 2 years and over must be rung and led by the ring and be under adequate chain around the neck or stout leather collar with adequate rope attached, as well as a halter. All females, yearling and over may be led by a nose clip (not ring). When an animal has been duly entered and catalogued in any class, the substitution of another animal will not be permitted without the consent of the Association.

The cow and heifer 2 year olds with a calf at foot to be judged. Points: Cow 70 points, calf 30 points. In aged classes June 1st taken as start of calving season. Animals must be purebred registered pedigrees in the All Breeds Section.

Animals not to leave grounds before 2.30 p.m. without the Chief Steward's permission. In all classes with calf at foot, calf must be natural progeny.
