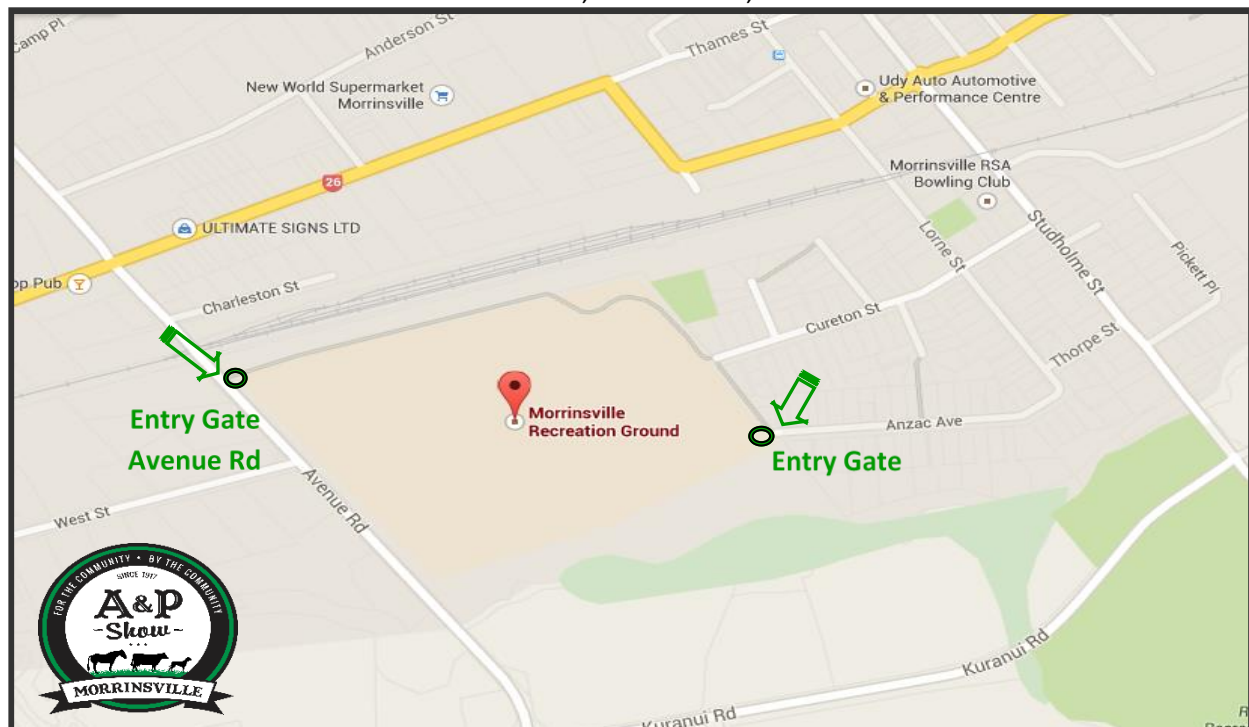

RULES FOR THE SHOW

ENTRIES CLOSE 19TH FEBRUARY - LATE ENTRIES AND ENTRIES ON THE DAY WILL BE ACCEPTED WITH A LATE ENTRY FEE AND YOU WILL HAVE TO PAY A GATE ENTRY IF THERE IS NOT ENOUGH TIME TO GET YOU YOUR TICKETS. WHICH IS NOT REFUNDABLE.

RULES:

Clean Sport- This applies to all sections of the A&P Show. Any animal maybe be tested for drugs or forbidden substances at any Show under the By Laws and Regulations adopted by the RAS and procedures adopted by the CSIC.

Exhibitors or Persons entering or competing in Shows or Events affiliated to the RAS shall be deemed to accept and be bound by these By-Laws Regulations & Procedures.

Drugs & Forbidden Substances means any substance capable of effecting speed, stamina, courage, conformation or conduct of an animal by its action upon or cardio-vascular, respiratory, alimentary, digestive, musco skeletal or urogenital systems.

Please note that the Morrinsville A & P Society is no longer registered for GST.

Refunding Entry Fees: A refund of fees will be made on presentation of a doctor's or Veterinary Certificate, at the discretion of the committee. Please note that on-line entry fees are non-refundable

All entries received must be paid for when the entry is submitted

Entries close 19th February, LATE entries are liable for an additional fee of \$10.00.per exhibit.

Each exhibitor must supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazards created or accident, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves or their animals at the show grounds. Exhibitors must comply with appropriate Animal Legislation and the Health & Safety in Employment Act 2015 and amendments thereafter. By entering the Show you agree to abide by the terms and conditions of the Morrinsville A & P Society.

If suitable, classes with less than three entries may be combined.

For classes with a small number of entries Prize Money will be paid as follows:

Three competitors or less – 1st Prize only will be paid out

Four competitors – 1st and 2nd prizes will be paid out

Five competitors or more – 1st, 2nd and 3rd prizes will be paid.

The Morrinsville A & P Society or any other organisations in conjunction with the show will not be held accountable for any cancellation of all or part of the show. Refunds will be looked at due to unforeseen circumstances and you will be contacted accordingly

Protests: Covering all Sections.

All protests must be in writing and must be entered with the Secretary **no later than 15 minutes after the event.**

The party entering a protest must deposit \$100.00

The deposit will be returned if the protest is sustained. The Committee will decide all protests as soon as practicable and there shall be no appeal from their decision.

Protest Committee are: President & (Secretary or Vice President) and Chief Steward of the ring concerned.

'Yellow Card' System

"This Show supports the RAS 'Yellow Card' system, which will operate in the Equestrian Section of all RAS affiliated Shows and will be offered for any inappropriate behavior towards Show Officials, Judges, fellow competitors or any other third party connected with the Show bringing the equestrian discipline into disrepute, or cases which are of a less serious nature to the above in accordance with the Conduct of Members Owners Lessees Competitors and/or Exhibitors as provide in the RAS Equestrian Competitors and Judges Rulebook of the RAS Constitution.

Implementation of the 'Yellow Card' will be in accordance of the RAS Rules that accompanied this card, and full working of the 'Yellow card' system is available to view on the RAS Website.

Covid 19

1. Covid 19 regulations and restrictions will be in place as per Government instructions at the time of the Show.
2. Refunds will be at the discretion of the Organising Committee and will be looked at for unforeseen circumstances and you will be contacted accordingly.
3. The Morrinsville A & P Society or any other organizations in conjunction with the Show will not be held accountable for any cancellation of all or part of the show.
4. If any competitor is showing flu-like symptoms, we advise that you do not attend this event.
5. The Morrinsville A & P Society will follow government guide lines but will not be held responsible if Covid 19 is contracted at the Show.

DAIRY GOATS

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

All exhibitors must be registered with NZDGBA, Premier or Anglo Nubian of New Zealand.

All exhibits must be led and tied up.

Does in milk must not be milked out before they are judged, (except in the second part of the best uddered class).

Does will not be penalized if it is found necessary to ease their udders before or during judging owing to their udders becoming overstocked.

Judging, all entries must be ready for judging by 10.00 a.m.

Standard minimum show Schedule for Herd register and associated records for Dairy Goats.

All entries must comply with the Rules of the Royal Agricultural Society of NZ and the Rules and Regulations of the NZDGBA for exhibiting Dairy Goats.

Prizes: 1st \$10, 2nd \$7, 3rd \$5

Vouchers or Product may be given in place of Prize Money

Class 704 Herd Register Grand Champion Doe

Open to any Doe which has obtained her Grand Champion status

NO award will be made if there is no competition.

CHAMPION CHALLENGE

To be selected from the winner of Class 704 and the Champion Doe.

Class 706 Associated Record Doe in Milk under 3 years

Class 707 Associated Record Doe in Milk 3 years and under 5 years

Class 708 Associated Record Doe in Milk 5 years and over

CHAMPION ASSOCIATED RECORD DOE

To be selected from the first-place getter in classes 706 - 708

RESERVE CHAMPION ASSOCIATED RECORD DOE

The second-place getter in the class which the Champion was selected to be paraded with the other first place getter for selection of Reserve.

Class 710 Associated Record Grand Champion Doe

Open to any Doe which has obtained her Grand Champion status

CHAMPION CHALLENGE

To be selected from the winner of Classes 710 and the Champion Doe.

No award will be made if there is no competition

SPECIAL IN MILK CLASSES**Class 712 Senior Progeny: 2 Daughters in Milk of same sire**

Two Daughters in milk of same sire but different Dams. Registration number and name of Sire and names of Dames to be given on entry form

Class 713 Dam and Daughter

Dam and one or more Daughters Judged on the Dams worth as a breeding Matron

Class 714 Herd Register Type and Production 1

Rules as per NZDGBA regulations

Class 715 Associated Records Type and Production

Rules as per NZDGBA regulations

Class 716 Herd Register Best Udder

Open to all who have borne a kid. To be judged when full and again when stripped out. Points awarded for both full and empty udder, to be totaled to determine the place getters. Does maybe eased before judging and must be stripped prior to entering the ring for the empty udder judging.

Class 717 Associated Records Best Udder

Held in the same conditions as in class 716

Class 718 Junior Show Person

For young persons of 15 years and under. To be judged on exhibitors' ability to lead, place, turn, stop and start their goat. To answer two questions. Show preparation and appearance of exhibitor and goat taken into account. Exhibitors age to be included on entry form plus their grade, (bronze, silver, gold, advance).

Class 719 Junior Herdsperson

15 years up to 25 years showing an adult goat. To be judged on presentation and knowledge of the anatomy of the animal also the handling and health of the adult goat. Does not have to belong to the exhibitor.

Standard Age Classes for Junior Does**Class 720 Herd Register Maiden Doe or Goatling**

To be 12 months and under 30 months, that has never borne a kid, including maiden milkers and springing Does.

Class 721 Herd Register Maiden Doe Kid

Born on or before the 31st August

Class 722 Herd Register Doe Kid - Born after 31 August**HERD REGISTER CHAMPION JUNIOR DOE**

To be selected from the first-place getters in classes 720, 721 and 722.

HERD REGISTER RESERVE CHAMPION JUNIOR DOE

The second-place getter in the class from which the Champion was selected to be paraded with the other first place getters for the selection of reserve

Class 724 Associate Record maiden Doe or Goatling

To be 12 months and under 30 months that has never borne a kid, including maiden milkers and springing Does.

Class 725 Associate Record Doe Kid

Born on or before 31st August

Class 726 Associate Record Doe Kid

Born after the 31st August

ASSOCIATED RECORDED CHAMPION JUNIOR DOE

To be selected from the first-place getters in classes 724, 725, 726

ASSOCIATE RECORD RESERVE CHAMPION JUNIOR DOE

The second-place getter in the class from which the Champion was selected to be paraded with the other first place getters for selection of the Reserve.

Junior Special Classes

Class 728 Junior Progeny

Two daughters under 30 months that have not borne a kid of the same Sire but different Dams.

Registration number and name of Sire and names of Dams to be given on entry form.

Buck Classes

Class 729 BUCK KID RECORDED GRADE - Buck Kid under 12 months

Class 730 BUCKS RECORDED GRADE- Bucks over 12 months

CHAMPION AND RESERVE CHAMPION RECORDED GRADE BUCK

Class 732 Buck Kid Under 12 months

Class 733 Buckling 12 months and under 2 years

Class 734 Buck - 2 years and over

CHAMPION BUCK

To be selected from classes 733, 734

RESERVE CHAMPION BUCK

The second-place getter in the class from which the Champion was selected to be paraded with the other first place getter for selection of the Reserve.

Class 736 Grand Champion Herd Register Buck

Open to any Buck which has obtained his Grand Champion status.

CHAMPION CHALLENGE

To be selected from the winner of Class 728 and the Champion Buck.
NO award will be made if there is no competition.
